PROJECT SUMMARY

Every dollar you donated went to direct assistance in Vietnam.

During the 2018 financial year we carried out a wide range of projects. This included encouraging children to attend school, medicines for a group of orphanages, and provisions to disadvantaged families.

Free range livestock projects to raise household income were in Cần Thơ, Đồng Nai, Dak Lak, Phong Nha, Hà Tĩnh, Quỳnh Lập Leper Colony, Nghệ An, Phát Diệm.

100% of every dollar donated went to direct assistance in Vietnam, because we have \$0 admin cost. This financial year, donation income was **\$16,335** and we spent **\$18,286** on projects summarised below. Funds were personally administered by us and our local helper network.




